READING ROCKS!!!!!!!!!!!!!!

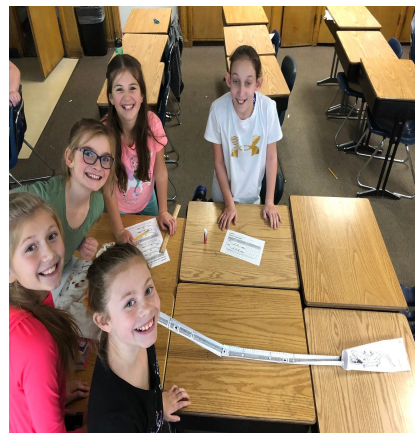
